**ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINAL DECISION TO ISSUE A CLEAN AIR ACT PREVENTION OF  
SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PERMIT THAT REGULATES GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS  
PERMIT APPLICATION NO. PSD-TX-108130-GHG**

On February 6, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 (EPA) provided notice of, and requested public comment on, EPA's proposal to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) major permit authorizing the construction of a bulk energy storage system (Project) the Chamisa CAES at Tulia in Tulia, Swisher County, Texas. EPA's final decision grants conditional approval, in accordance with the PSD regulations (40 CFR 52.21), to Chamisa CAES at Tulia to construct a compressed air energy storage (CAES) facility capable of producing up to 270 MW of electrical power. EPA did not receive any written comments concerning the draft permit during the comment period, and did not receive any written requests for a public hearing.

The mailing address for Chamisa CAES at Tulia is 2300 North Ridgetop Road, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87506. The physical location for the Project is 1,000 meters west of I-27 intersection with SH 86.
