Dear Ms. Holt:

In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your application for a CAA Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) for Greenhouse Gas Emissions permit authorizing the construction of a new NGL fractionation plant.

The EPA issued and published requests for public comment regarding EPA's proposed action on the above application on August 7, 2013. During the comment period, EPA received one written comment letter, which included a statement expressing a "willing[ness] to attend" a hearing. When contacted by telephone to clarify whether the comment writer had intended to request a public hearing, the commenter orally requested a public hearing. In accordance with 40 CFR 124.12, the permitting authority evaluated whether there was a "a significant degree of public interest in [the] permit" and determined the degree of public interest was not significant enough to require a hearing. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes, regulations, and additional material relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD Permit for the facility described above. The final permit, Responses to Public Comments, and other key documents relevant to the final PSD permit are also available online at http://yosemite.epa.gov/r6/Apermit.nsf/AirP.

In accordance with 40 CFR §124.15(b), this PSD Permit becomes effective thirty (30) days from the date of service of notice of this permit decision unless a petition for review is properly and timely filed with the EAB. In the event that a petition for review is filed with the EAB, construction of the facility is not authorized under this PSD permit until resolution of the EAB petition(s).
