ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINAL DECISION TO ISSUE A CLEAN AIR ACT PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PERMIT THAT REGULATES GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS PERMIT APPLICATION NO. PSD-TX-1336-GHG

On March 7, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 (EPA) provided notice of, and requested public comment on, EPA's proposal to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) major permit authorizing the construction of a propane dehydrogenation unit near Mont Belvieu, Chambers County, Texas. EPA's final decision grants conditional approval, in accordance with the PSD regulations (40 CFR 52.21), to Enterprise Products LLC to construct a propane dehydrogenation unit and associated equipment capable of producing up to 1.6 billion pounds per year of propylene. The plant will also produce a secondary hydrogen product stream. EPA received one emailed, written comment concerning the draft permit during the comment period, but did not receive any written requests for a public hearing.
