## ONEOK Hydrocarbon, L.P., Mont Belvieu Natural Gas Liquids (NGL) Fractionation Plant

ANNOUNCEMENT OF PROPOSED PERMIT AND PUBLIC HEARING, AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF PROPOSED CLEAN AIR ACT GREENHOUSE GAS PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PRECONSTRUCTION PERMIT

Public Comment Period May 16, 2014 – June 16, 2014

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provides notice of and requests public comment on the EPA's proposed action relating to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit application for the ONEOK Mont Belvieu NGL Fractionation Plant. EPA is issuing notice of a draft PSD permit for the ONEOK facility in accordance with the PSD regulation (40 CFR 52.21) that if finalized would regulate the greenhouse gas (GHG) air pollutant emissions associated with the project to add two fractionation plants, at their existing facility, which is located at the following address: 11350 Fitzgerald Road, Baytown, TX 77523.

Under the provision of 40 CFR 52.21 (except paragraph (a)(1)), EPA Region 6 implements a GHG PSD Federal Implementation plan for Texas. *See 40 CFR 52.2305*. As the project will result in increased greenhouse gas emissions for a facility described at 40 CFR 52.21(b)(49)(v), EPA concludes that ONEOK's application is subject to PSD review for the pollutant GHGs. The proposed project will consist of the construction of two additional 75,000 barrel per day fractionation plants to process demethanized natural gas mixture into ethane, propane, isobutene, normal butane, and natural gasoline.

Any interested individual may submit written comments on EPA's proposed PSD permit for the ONEOK project. All comments must be received in writing by June 16, 2014, or postmarked by June 16, 2014, to Aimee Wilson at one of the following addresses:

EPA will respond to and consider all comments in making the final decision regarding the issuance of the permit. Similar comments may be grouped together in the response, and the EPA will not respond to individual commenters directly.

Additionally, all comments will be included in the public docket without change, and may be made available to the public, including any personal information provided, unless the comment includes Confidential Business Information (CBI) or other information whose disclosure is restricted by statute. Thus, CBI or other protected information should be clearly identified as such, and should not be submitted through email. Any emails sent directly to the EPA will capture your email address automatically, which will then be included as a part of the public comment. *Please note that an email or postal address must be provided with your comments if you wish to receive responses to comments submitted during the public comment period and direct notification of EPA's final decision regarding the permit.* 

An extension of the 30-day comment period may be granted if the request for an extension adequately demonstrates why additional time is required to prepare comments.

**Public Hearing:** If EPA determines that there is a significant amount of public interest in the draft permit, the EPA has the right to hold a public hearing. Any requests for a public hearing must be received by the EPA either by email or mail by June 6, 2014, and must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Attendance at the public hearing is not required in order to submit written comments. *If the EPA determines that there is significant public interest*, a public hearing will be held on June 25, 2014, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the following location:

If a public hearing is held, the public comment period shall automatically be extended to the close of the public hearing. EPA has the right to cancel a public hearing if no request for a public hearing is received by June 6, 2014, or EPA determines that there is not significant interest. If *the hearing is cancelled*, EPA will post an announcement of the cancellation by June 11, 2014, on EPA's website <a href="http://yosemite.epa.gov/r6/Apermit.nsf/AirP">http://yosemite.epa.gov/r6/Apermit.nsf/AirP</a>. Individuals may also call the EPA at the above contact number to determine if the public hearing has been cancelled.

**Permit Documents:** EPA's draft permit, EPA's preliminary determination and statement of basis, ONEOK's permit application and supporting documentation, and comments received from the public, other government agencies, and the applicant during the public comment period become part of the administrative record.
