ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINAL DECISION TO ISSUE A CLEAN AIR ACT PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PERMIT THAT REGULATES GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS PERMIT APPLICATION NO. PSD-TX-1378-GHG

On May 28, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 (EPA) provided notice of, and requested public comment on, EPA's proposal to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) major permit authorizing the construction of a new generation station near Shiro, Grimes County, Texas. EPA's final decision grants conditional approval, in accordance with the PSD regulations (40 CFR 52.21), to Tenaska Roan's Prairie Partners, LLC to construct a new generation station and associated equipment capable of providing up to approximately 694 nominal gross megawatts of power to supplement the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power grid during periods of peak power demand. The EPA received one comment letter concerning the draft permit during the comment period, but did not receive any written requests for a public hearing.

Within 30 days after the service of notice announcing this final permit decision, any person who filed comments on the proposed permit for the Project or participated in any of the public hearings for the Project may petition EPA's Environmental Appeals Board (EAB) to review any condition of the final permit. Persons who did not file comments or participate in the public hearings may petition for administrative review only to the extent of changes from the proposed to the final permit decision. The petition must include a statement of the reason(s) for requesting

review by the EAB, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period to the extent required by the regulations at 40 CFR Part 124 and when appropriate, a showing that the conditions in question are based on 1) a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is erroneous, or 2) an exercise of discretion or an important policy consideration which the EAB should, in its discretion, review. EPA's PSD permit for the Project shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of service of notice of this permit decision unless a petition for review is properly and timely filed with the EAB. In the event that a petition for review is filed with the EAB, construction of the facility is not authorized under this PSD permit until resolution of the EAB petition(s).
