Purpose/Objectives/Goals

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to outline collaboration efforts on the advancement, development and implementation of Green Chemistry between the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA), an executive branch agency, and the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), an agency of the State of California. This MOU is entered into between US EPA and DTSC to establish relations between the two institutions regarding collaboration on their mutual goals on Green Chemistry. US EPA and DTSC are referred to herein as “the Parties” to this MOU.
