The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above-referenced document pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

Based on our review, we have rated the SDEIS as Lack of Objections (LO) (see enclosed "Summary of Rating Definitions"). EPA supports the proposed regulatory changes to revise the Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary (CINMS) discharge regulations. The new regulations will better enable the CINMS to ensure protection of its valuable resources by preventing potentially harmful effects of sewage and graywater discharges from large ships. We commend the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) for their work on this project and their efforts to protect California's rich offshore marine ecosystems.
