## FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

### Northeast Water Storage Reservoir Replacement Project Placer County, California

#### Project Location and Description

The City of Roseville has requested \$578,800 from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to fund the replacement of their northeast water storage reservoir in Placer County, CA. The EPA is considering fulfilling this funding request.

#### Purpose and Need for the Proposed Action

The purpose and need of the proposed action are to eliminate the potential seismic hazard presented by the City of Roseville's existing 6 million gallon (MG) water storage reservoir (tank), and have a tank that meets current seismic safety standards, in order to maintain reliable and flexible treated water service to the City's residential, industrial and commercial customers.

#### Environmental Consequences

An Environmental Assessment was prepared for the City of Roseville's Northeast Water Storage Reservoir Replacement Project in conformance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Detailed analyses of the project are contained in the EA. The EPA has determined that the action will not have a significant impact on the quality of the environment. Consequently, EPA has made the decision to prepare this Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and to not prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)
