The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above-referenced document pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508) and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

The FEIS describes the proposal for managing the Sweetwater Marsh and South San Diego Bay Units of the San Diego Bay National Wildlife Refuge over the next 15 years. These two Refuge Units encompass approximately 2,620 acres of land and water in and around San Diego Bay. Refuge habitat provides essential resting, foraging, and nesting habitat for tens of thousands of migratory shorebirds and wintering waterfowl. The FEIS evaluates three alternatives for the Sweetwater Marsh Unit and four alternatives for the South San Diego Bay Unit. Alternative C (Implement Habitat Enhancement and Restoration and Improve Existing Public Uses) is the preferred alternative for the Sweetwater Marsh Unit; Alternative D (Expand Habitat Management, Enhance Nesting Opportunities, Maximize Habitat Restoration, and Provide Additional Public Use Opportunities) is the preferred alternative for the South San Diego Bay Unit. EPA has no objection to the preferred alternatives and supports their habitat enhancement and restoration goals.
