The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the Federal Register Notice published on September 4, 2009, describing National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's intent to adopt the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's Final Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (Final PEIS) for the South Bay Salt Pond Restoration Project (CEQ #20070539). Our comments are provided pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

Because your agency is adopting the Final PEIS that EPA previously reviewed and commented on, we would like to highlight the remaining concern shared with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service upon completion of that document. At that time, EPA identified concerns related to the likely future non-attainment status for the San Francisco Bay area for the 24-hour standard for particulate matter with a diameter of 2.5 microns or less (PM_{2.5}). We have enclosed EPA's entire January 28, 2008 comment letter for your reference and consideration in your adoption of the Final PEIS.
