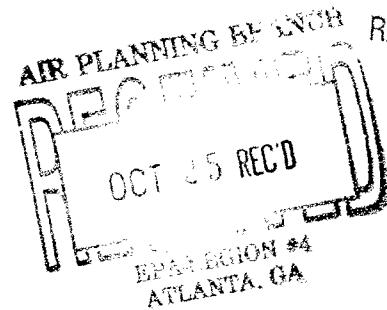

Dear Ms. Fleming:

On March 12, 2009, the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) submitted a letter concerning the State's nonattainment area recommendations for the 2008 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS). Based on 2006-2008 monitoring data, the following counties exceeded the NAAQS and were recommended for nonattainment: Jefferson, Shelby, Madison, Mobile and Baldwin. The purpose of this letter is to revise the previous recommendations to reflect the most recent monitoring data. Based on certified 2008-2010 monitoring data, all Alabama monitors meet the 2008 8-hour ozone NAAQS.

Enclosed, please find a table which provides data from our ozone monitoring network. The information provided is based on monitoring data from 2008 to 2010, inclusive. This data supports our recommendation that all Alabama counties are in attainment of the 2008 ozone NAAQS and should be designated as such.
