Dear Mr. Grams:

In July 1997, the Environmental Protection Agency promulgated a new National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for ozone. In accordance with section 107(d) of the Clean Air Act, EPA must provide an initial list of areas that do not meet the new standard within two years of its promulgation date. This deadline was delayed one year by section 107(d) of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century, making the resultant deadline for EPA attainment designations July of 2000.

According to the Clean Air Act, the Governor of each State must use air monitoring data to designate areas within the State that do not meet the new standard, and provide this information as a recommendation to EPA for its non-attainment area designations. A review of Iowa's 1997-1999 ozone monitoring data indicates that none of the ozone monitors in Iowa measured violations of the new standard. I therefore request that EPA designate all counties in Iowa as attainment/unclassifiable with respect to the new ozone NAAQS.
