RE: The Pueblo of San Ildefonso designation recommendation for the 8-hour ozone  
National Ambient Air Quality Standard

Dear Mr. Cooke:

On behalf of the Pueblo of San Ildefonso I wish to recommend that our Pueblo air shed be designated as an attainment/unclassifiable area. We realize the uncertainties regarding implementation of the 8-hour ozone, nevertheless, our recommendation is based on the New Mexico Ozone Air Quality Data for 1997-1999 attainment boundaries of the surrounding Consolidated/Metropolitan Statistical Areas (C/MSA) and that there is not sufficient data specifically for our Tribal air shed thus we would fall under the attainment/unclassifiable designation.
