Dear Mr. Iani:

Enclosed on behalf of the Governor is the state of Washington's recommendations for designations for the 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard. This submittal responds to your March 31, 2003, request to Governor Locke for submittal of recommendations by July 15, 2003.

The state of Washington recommends that the entire state, except for tribal lands, be designated "attainment/unclassifiable." The enclosed analysis of ozone monitoring for the 3-year period of 2000-2002 shows that all monitored areas of the state met the eight-hour standard. This result supports the recommendation of "attainment/unclassifiable." This is the same recommendation that the state made to EPA in 2000. Consistent with federal and state policy, we recognize that tribal lands are not affected because tribes have authority over air quality within the boundaries of their reservations.

The listing of areas we are proposing for EPA inclusion in 40 CFR Part 81 is enclosed. In accordance with EPA guidance on 8-hour ozone designations, the listing specifies those Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Areas (CMSAs) or Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) where we are monitoring ozone. As requested, we are submitting the state's recommended listing in both written and electronic form.

Should it be necessary to redesignate an area as "nonattainment" sometime in the future, we intend to evaluate the factors specified in the EPA guidance on the 8-hour designations and any other relevant considerations before recommending a nonattainment area boundary, rather than simply using CMSA or MSA boundaries as defaults.
