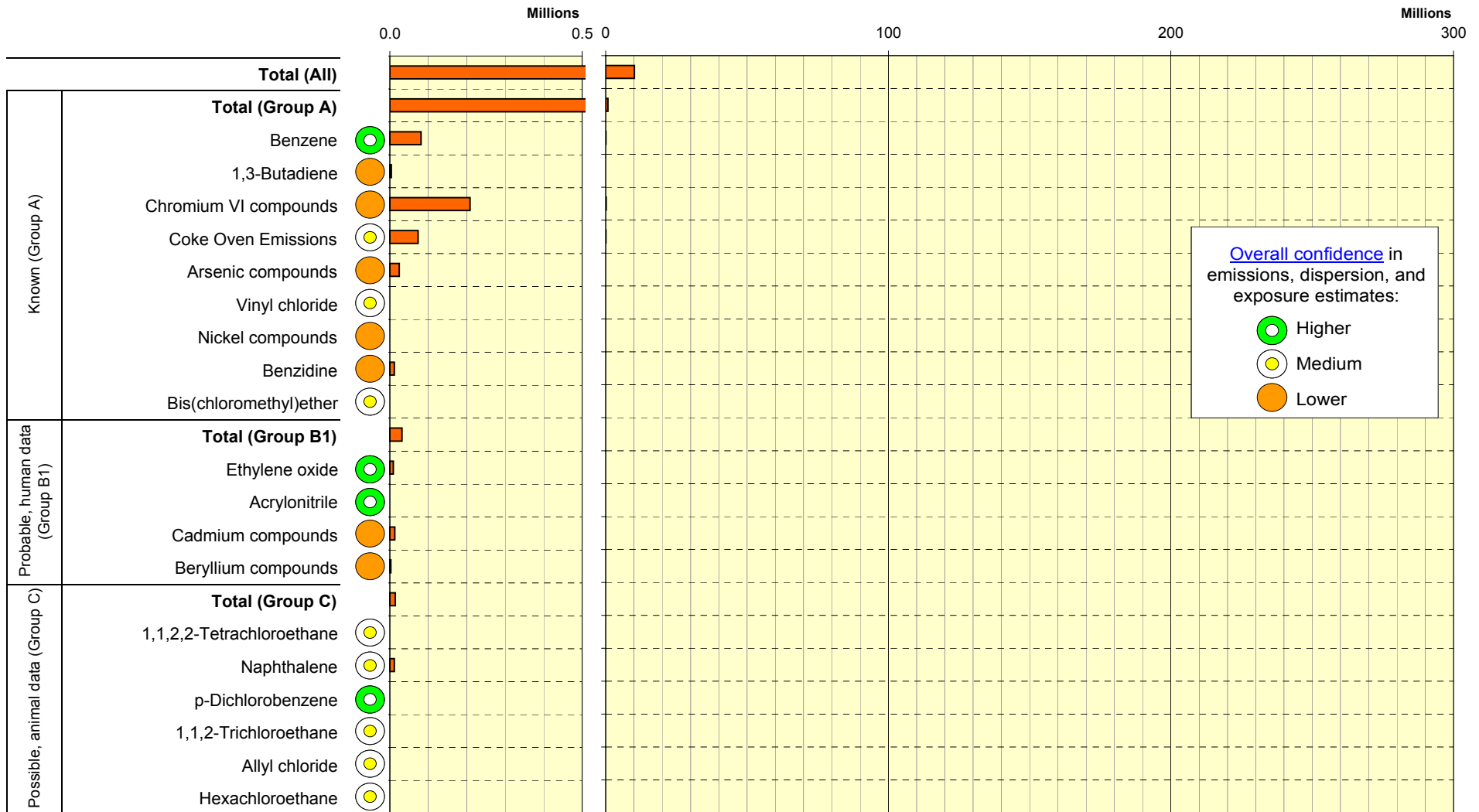

Population residing in census tracts for which the 1999 median exposure exceeded a lifetime cancer risk level of 100 in 1 million (based on all sources combined).



Results are based on inhalation exposure to outdoor sources only. Although these results assume continuous exposure to 1999 levels of air toxics over a lifetime, current and planned control programs are expected to substantially reduce these exposures and associated cancer risk for some pollutants.
