Additional Comments :

Parvez Mallick (EPA) and Adam Davis (START) met Jay Shaw (CTEH) and Christopher Daigle (CTEH) at the site with the intent to collect a sample of Oily Contaminated Material (OCM). Stephanie Hopper of ADEM was present during the site visit/sampling event. We met with Brian Herrick (Patriot) and Steve Green (Patriot) at the site. This site had no roll off containers for contaminated material. All PPE from this site is classified as Oily Contaminated Material. This PPE is double bagged and placed into drums next to each decontamination pad. These drums are then taken to the Theodore Site 4 Staging Area and placed into roll off containers. According to Michael Dockens (WM representative at the Theodore Site 4 Staging Area) only oily contaminated material from the Theodore Decon Area is staged at the Theodore Site 4 Staging Area. No samples were taken from the Theodore Decon Area since a sample was taken from the Theodore Site 4 Staging Area. No concerns regarding waste management practices were noted during this visit.
