# Euphorbia corollata

## Flowering Spurge



Blue-green foliage and many, many small white flowers (the white "petals" are actually bracts). Blooms all summer. Foliage turns bright red in the fall. Great for dry sites.

**Suggested companions:** arrow-leaved aster (*Aster sagittifolius*), round-headed bush clover (*Lespedeza capitata*), little bluestem (*Schizachyrium scoparium*), virginia creeper (*Parthenocissus quinquefolia*), bur oak (*Quercus macrocarpa*).
