Also called wild oats, and bellwort. Soft green foliage, and dangling, bell-shaped yellow flowers. Spreads to form a loose, open colony.

Suggested companions: blue phlox (*Phlox divaricata*), lady fern (*Athyrium filix-femina*), Jack-in-the-pulpit (*Arisaema triphyllum*), wild geranium (*Geranium maculatum*)
