# What steps are being taken to ensure the workers in the Gulf are protected?

### I'm out of work because of the oil spill. How can I get help?

President Obama arranged with BP on June 15 to compensate workers and business owners who have been harmed as a result of the spill. The next day, BP began a \$20 billion claims fund that is being controlled by an independent party to ensure claims are paid out quickly and fairly. This process is free of charge.
