OPP Update May 2015

Background

- Executive Order 13563, "Improving Regulation and Regulatory Review"
 - Signed January 2011
 - Goal: make regulations more effective or less burdensome
 - Directs federal agencies to review existing regulations to identify possible reforms that modify, streamline, expand or repeal those regulations

Initial Plan for Periodic Retrospective Review

- Plan issued in 2011 after extensive public engagement
- Identified 35 retrospective reviews
- Opened a docket to receive ongoing suggestions
 Docket named: Improving Regulations: Pesticides, number EPA-HQ-OA-2011-0157
- EPA posts semi-annual progress reports on our website http://yosemite.epa.gov/opei/RuleGate.nsf/

Ongoing Reviews

2011 EPA plan commits to ongoing and periodic reviews

- Continues to assess existing significant regulations
- Welcomes public suggestions for reviews
- Sets out a 4-step process every 5-years to identify retrospective reviews

January 2015 update

- EPA completed 21 of its original 35 retrospective reviews
- Five new reviews were added in July 2014
- 19 reviews were ongoing

OPP Activities under the Retrospective Review

OPP fully participated in EPA implementation

- EPA public engagement activities and meetings (2011)
- Listening session with the PPDC (2011)
- Initiated five retrospective reviews (2011)

OPP Completed Two Reviews by 2015

- Export notification for pesticides
- Integrated pesticide registration reviews

Continued Efforts

- Modernizing science and technology methods
- Electronic online reporting
- Certification of pesticide applicators
- Confidential Statement of Product Specifications (CSPS) for Pesticides (new in 2014)
- FIFRA Pesticide Import Rule Revisions Referral (new in 2014)
