Thank you for the opportunity to review the proposed title V revisions for the first phase of the planned integration of the Carson and Wilmington Operations of the Tesoro Marketing & Refining Company to form the Tesoro Los Angeles Refinery, Facility ID's 174655 (Carson) and 800436 (Wilmington), and specifically permit application numbers 567617, 567642, 575838, 575876, 578248, 578249, 567439, 567643, 567645, 567646, 567647, 567648, 567649, 575837, 575839, 575840, 575841, 575874, 575875, and 567619.

In accordance with South Coast regulations and 40 CFR 70.8(c), EPA has 45 days from receipt of the proposed permits and all necessary supporting documentation to object in writing to its issuance. We are writing to notify you that EPA has reviewed the proposed permit package and has no further comments. The permits are now eligible for issuance. The public may petition the EPA Administrator to object to these permit revisions until September 6, 2017.

Please note that if a permit is later found to require corrective steps (including, but not limited to, reopening the permit for cause), the expiration of both EPA's review period and the public petition period without EPA objection does not compromise the Agency's authority to take such measures.
