(HSWA Cluster I)

Note: This codification rule incorporated numerous HSWA amendments to RCRA into the existing RCRA regulations. Since HSWA provides that States may seek authorization for selected provisions (instead of having to adopt all provisions simultaneously), this checklist has been subdivided into logical groupings of the HSWA early enactment provisions. 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RCRA REVISION CHECKLIST 17 B

Delisting

Note: Delisting is an optional requirement. If the State currently has a delisting program, then it must modify its delisting regulations to comply with these new standards. The changes to 260.22(b) were made at 54 FR 27114 (June 27, 1989). If a State was authorized for the changes addressed by this checklist prior to this rule's promulgation date, then the State need not make the required changes to 260.22(b) because these changes merely eliminate potential confusion as to existing regulatory requirements. However, States which are not authorized as of this date should make these changes if they choose to include delisting as part of their program.

Also, States submitting this checklist need to provide documentation regarding other delisting standards not covered by this checklist. The new SAM will contain a Consolidated Base Program Checklist addressing Part 260 requirements that may be helpful to a State preparing this documentation. The delisting program is addressed by 40 CFR 260.20 and 260.22.

Double Liners

Note: Corrections were made to 264.221(c) and 264.301(c) by a May 9, 1990 (55 FR 19262; Revision Checklist 77). This correction was based on a United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia decision (June 23, 1987), concerning a lawsuit filed against EPA. On January 29, 1992, EPA issued a final rule (57 FR 3462; Revision Checklist 100) that superceded the Revision Checklist 77 changes and expanded the 264.221(c) and 264.301(c) requirements, as promulgated by Revision Checklist 17 H. States not yet authorized for Revision Checklist 17 H are encouraged to adopt either the Revision Checklist 77 corrections or the Revision Checklist 100 changes at the same time the Revision Checklist 17 H provisions are adopted. States seeking authorization for Revision Checklist 100, that are not yet authorized for Revision Checklist 77, should also submit Revision Checklist 77 to receive "credit" for Revision Checklist 77 in StATS, even though Revision Checklist 100 has superceded these changes.
