

RCRA REVISION CHECKLIST 207 Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest Rule 70 FR 10776 – 10825 March 4, 2005 (RCRA Cluster XV, HSWA/Non-HSWA)

As amended on June 16, 2005 at 70 FR 35034

- A correction was made to this rule at 70 FR 35034 (June 16, 2005). The sections affected are: 40 CFR 262.20(a)(2), 262.33, the Manifest form and continuation sheet, 264.72(e)(4) and 265.72(e)(4). States are encouraged to adopt the correction at the same time that the March 4, 2005 provisions are adopted. Those states that will incorporate the July 1, 2005 Code of Federal Regulations by reference, should include language that references or otherwise includes the correction published in the Federal Register on June 16, 2005 to ensure accuracy of regulations.
- 2) As noted in a May 14, 2007 memorandum from Matt Hale, Director of the Office of Solid Waste, in 40 CFR 264.72(f)(2) and 265.72(f)(2), the March 4, 2005 final rule in advertently requires the designated facility to enter the generator's name and mailing address in Item 5 of the manifest. Designated facilities should enter their own information in Item 5 of the manifest in cases of rejected shipments. This checklist reflects the correction of this error.
- 3) States are encouraged to adopt these provisions and begin implementing them while seeking authorization.

Note that revisions to 262.27 were promulgated pursuant to HSWA.
