<sup>3 40</sup> CFR 267.150 applies only to unauthorized States and is not appropriate in the code of States applying for authorization. This situation is analogous to that for 40 CFR 264.150.

<sup>4</sup> Note that § 270.10(a) has been completely revised by Revision Checklist 210 by subdividing the previously existing paragraph into multiple subparagraphs (a)(1) through (5). Although the information contained in these subparagraphs is substantially similar to the language as it existed previously, the format is newly revised.
