occurs) of all used CRTs						
exported during the previous						
calendar year. Such reports						
must also include the following:

address of the exporter;

CRT exporters of used, intact	261.41(b)					
CRTs sent for reuse must keep						
copies of normal business						
records, such as contracts,						
demonstrating that each						
shipment of exported used,						
intact CRTs will be reused. This						
documentation must be retained						
for a period of at least three						
years from the date the CRTs						
were exported. If the documents						
are written in a language other						
than English, CRT exporters of						
used, intact CRTs sent for reuse						
must provide both the original,						
non-English version of the						
normal business records as well						
as a third-party translation of						
the normal business records into						
English within 30 days upon						
request by EPA.
