Action Plan based on Final Recommendations – February 12, 2012

AEP has reviewed the final report provided by Dewberry and Davis, LLC as part of their assessment of the ash impoundment facilities at the Flint Creek Power Plant. We note that the facility was found to be satisfactory and that there were no recommendations.

1.2 RECOMMENDATIONS

No recommendations appear warranted at this time.

Response:

AEP will continue its dam inspection and maintenance program (DIMP). Quarterly inspections of the facility are performed by Plant personnel and AEP Engineering conducts an annual inspection.

AEP fully understands that maintenance of the facilities is part of the actions required to ensure the integrity of the dams and dikes at the AEP facilities. Therefore, AEP will continue a proactive maintenance and monitoring program as established.
