

## **Coalition Accomplishments**


**Funding**: ∼ \$12.1M

  - State \$2.4M to PGF school bus work
  - CMAQ \$625K
  - DERA \$592K, portion to PGF school bus work
  - ARRA \$1.73M
- MEI
  - EPA 8 grants, 3 regions \$4.78M
  - State and Local Govt. \$564K
  - Private Foundation \$315K
  - Corporate \$1.1M

## **Coalition Accomplishments**

- State Diesel Emission Reduction Strategy with MEI,
   MPCA, EPA, and coalition partners
- MEI/CAM/MnTAP printer and auto body projects
- MEI and PGF coalition
  - State and National awards
  - >1850 school buses (~180,000 students)
  - >405 heavy-duty diesel engines (trucks, buses, trains, construction equipment; multiple technologies)

  - 367 heavy-duty public entity trucks; including 30 fire trucks








#### Recovery Act
