First Steps

- Can We Decrease What Gets Into the Environment?
 - Takeback viewed as most promising approach
 - Involve prescribers in reducing number of pills
- What Could be Done Before Regs
 - Split on whether we should or can do anything
 - Need to show there is a problem cause & effect
 - Need prioritization process to decide which pharms first
 - Reg changes needed
 - Treatment options need to be developed
 - Study successful takeback programs in other countries

Trash Not Flush

- Consumer Education
 - Educational materials made & distributed
 - Outreach to special groups, i.e., hospices
 - Print disposal instructions right on Rx bag
 - Guidance from regulatory agencies on disposal
 - FDA provide guidance on disposal no flush

Product Stewardship

- Pharm companies have a responsibility to ensure the proper disposal of their products
- Pharm companies should explore making their products more environmentally benign
- Can pharms be made and/or a method developed to render pharms unuseable and unrecoverable at home & safe for disposal?

Data Gaps

- Analytical or Biological Methods
- Treatment technologies Fast tracked
- Pilot projects to examine options
- Don't wait for regs reuse issues a driver
- EPA provide guidance on best treatment technologies
- RO effective but removes nutrients
- Stormwater as a pathway for pharms
- Develop Expert System for RCRA waste classes
