- Sent the newly developed Autobody CD with links to important regulatory and pollution prevention information to all shops in the pilot area (copies available upon request)
- Continued to participate in the Collision Repair Interagency calls with EPA and partners.
- Refined master list of shops, based on business and address corrections obtained during baseline visits and mail outs to shops.
- Sent randomized lists of shops to be visited for verification site visits to all local jurisdictions. The verification site visits have begun and should be completed by August, 2010.
