**Mobile Source Present and Future Models Workshop to be held
November 5-7, 2002**

This announcement notifies all interested parties of the Mobile Source Present and Future Models workshop, which will be held in Ann Arbor, MI on Tuesday through Thursday November 5-7, 2002. The workshop will be held at the Sheraton Inn, 3200 Boardwalk, Ann Arbor, MI 48108, and will run from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:00 p.m. each day.
