On behalf of Governor Knowles, I recommend that all of Alaska be designated as an attainment area for the new eight-hour ozone standard. Atmospheric conditions and pollutant levels indicate that ozone pollution should not be a problem in Alaska, and past and current monitoring around the state confirm this. This letter satisfies the conditions of Section 107 of the Clean Air Act.
