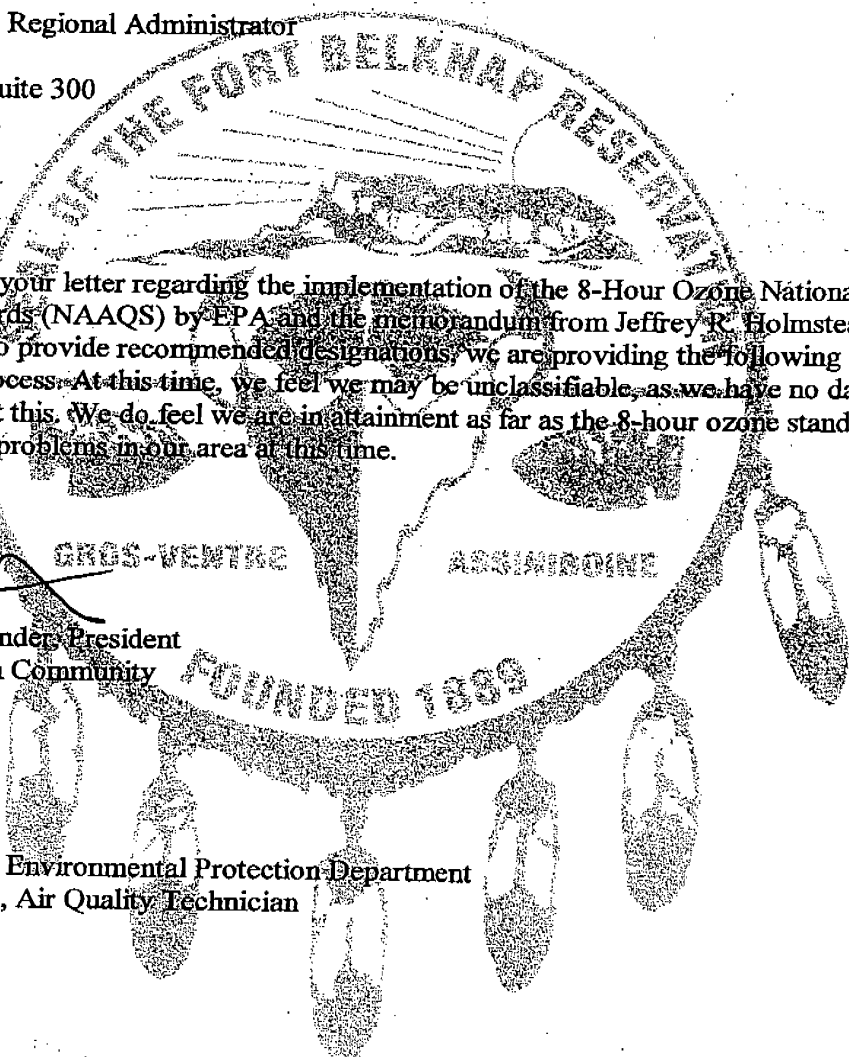

In response to your letter regarding the implementation of the 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) by EPA and the memorandum from Jeffrey R. Holmstead requesting Tribes to provide recommended designations, we are providing the following input in this designation process.
