Dear Mr. Welsh:

On April 30, 2004, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) promulgated non-attainment designations and classifications for the eight-hour ozone national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS). 69 Fed. Reg. 23858. These designations and classifications were effective on June 15, 2004. Pennsylvania is formally requesting that EPA reclassify Lancaster County, currently a "moderate" eight-hour ozone non-attainment area, to a "marginal" eight-hour ozone non-attainment area in accordance with Section 181 (a)(4) of the 1990 Amendments of the Clean Air Act (CAA). 42. U.S.C. § 7511(a)(4). We have attached a report for your consideration supporting this reclassification.
