Thank you for your April 9, 2003, letter regarding recommendations for designations with respect to the 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard.

As indicated in Jeffrey Holmstead's February 27, 2003, guidance "Extension for States and Tribes to Submit Air Quality Designation Recommendations for the 8-Hour Ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards," the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) anticipates that it will designate areas no later than April 15, 2004. The EPA will notify you of any modifications we plan to make to your recommendation no later than 120 days prior to promulgating designations.
