The purpose of this letter is to submit a 5 percent reclassification request for Kent and Queen Anne's Counties with respect to the 8-hour ozone standard. These counties were recently designated a Moderate 8-hour ozone nonattainment area and we are requesting that they be reclassified as a Marginal 8-hour ozone nonattainment area based on EPA's 5 percent reclassification guidance.
