Exemption for Bacillus thuringiensis.

On March 15, 1988 several members of PM Team 17 discussed with the HED Biotech Workgroup how the tolerance exemption stated in 40 CFR 180.1011 applies. It was decided that the tolerance exemption is applicable to all B. thuringiensis strains and use patterns. Unless I am notified within two weeks from the date of this memo, I will assume that all addressees concur with this interpretation of 40 CFR 180.1011.
