[REDACTED] The inerts have been previously cleared.

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Uses:

A non-selective herbicide used to control a wide range of perennial weeds and grasses.

Precautionary Statement:

Koroc; it is acceptable since the product falls in Tox Cat. III.

Data: A registration standard for Bromacil has been approved. The toxicology data for the [REDACTED] applies to this 5% dilution. Sufficient data are available.

Data Gaps: **PRODUCT INGREDIENT SOURCE INFORMATION IS NOT INCLUDED**

Second studies in Chronic Feeding, Oncogenicity and Teratogenicity are in progress. The submitted data for the 3 subjects (one study for each) have been accepted by the Tox Branch. (The 3 studies have been reviewed and used for previous actions and the Standard)

Conclusions: No unreasonable adverse effects are foreseen by granting this request.

There are no pending regulatory actions against this product, and it is not on the RPAR list.

Note: The product may induce thyroid changes, thus a chronic study using dogs has been previously requested by this reviewer.
