The attached document, on the mutagenicity of Diquat, is submitted for your review and consideration on whether the swimming provisions on registered Chevron Diquat Water Weed Killer product should be restored and required for other manufacturers of Diquat as well.

Dr. Bruce Molholt, of my staff, undertook an indepth study of the toxicological effects of Diquat in the human study following an incident involving a Diquat application to a northwestern Pennsylvania lake.
