**I. Introduction**

1. See evaluation dated June 24, 1970
2. Revision of 7-1-71
  - a. Sugar Cane (Puerto Rico only) 1/2 pt. in 4 gal. 7A by air. Repeat as necessary. PHI 2 months. Do not pasture livestock in treated areas.
  - b. Alfalfa PHI 1 day.
  - c. Broccoli, cabbage, cauliflower, Brussels sprouts, celery, and grapes. PHI 1 day.
  - d. Beans and soybeans forage - 7 days of harvest or foraging.
  - e. Sugar beets PHI 2 days.
  - f. Cotton - do not graze within 14 days after application.
  - g. Alfalfa - PHI 1 day, do not graze treated fields.
  - h. Hops - PHI 4 days, do not feed hopyard waste.
3. All uses in this petition are registered with the exception of Sugarcane and petitioner withdrew sugarcane.

**II. Recommendation**

All uses registered, and we have been told to accept registered uses when a tolerance is given. Therefore, we will have to go along with the registration when the tolerance is established.

Pat: Previous evaluation had in our opinion. We do not give opinions now, but if we did it would be the same.
