The petitioner has submitted a revised Section B in response to two deficiencies raised in a reject letter from COB (C. M. Young, 10/21/74).

The amendment proscribes label restrictions limiting the applications to one per growing season and restricting the use to North and South Carolina only.

This action resolves the final CB objections to the proposal; therefore, we now recommend for the establishment of the proposed tolerance of 0.05 ppm (negligible residue) for residues of trifluralin in or on field corn grain, fodder, and forage; and fresh corn (kernels and cob) with husk removed.

We note that TB and EEEB are not objecting to this proposal.
