Background

The basic chemistry data for endothall are available. The manufacturing process and the percentage composition of the technical chemical were submitted in Petition 3F1416. Analytical methods for the active ingredient in formulations are available.

Proposed temporary permit (Rice)

Formulation: Granules containing 11.2% of mono
(N,N-dimethylalkylamine*) salt of
endothall *as in coconut oil fatty
acids (5% acid)

Label : Up to 60 lbs. formulation per acre,
depending on depth of water; air or
ground equipment: 10 day holding
period before releasing treated water

Acreage : 5000
Pounds of formulation: 200,000
Pounds endothall acid : 10,000

Conclusion

CB has sufficient basic information to agree to this permit.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the permit be issued when the temporary tolerance is established.
