Action Requested: Union Carbide has requested a new source of NAA, its sodium salt and its amide and ethyl ester. [redacted] and according to the RCB memo of Feb. 3, 1982 by Richard Loranger, the old and new products are not identical.

Recommendation: Based on my comparison of the analysis of [redacted] I find that any difference between them is incrementally negligible.
