The following two acute studies were included in a Ciba-Geigy submission dated 5-5-75.

Acute Aerosol Inhalation (Rat)

At 156.5 mg/l hyperexcitability and salivation were observed during and immediately after the 1-hour exposure and remained normal over the 14-day observation period.

Acute Dermal LD₅₀ (Rabbit)=3600+326.6 mg/kg

Toxic signs: ataxia, depression, diarrhea, collapse followed by death.

No label changes are necessitated by the above data.
