In our review of this petition (memo of 3/5/82, K. Arne) we recommended for the proposed tolerance on sunflower hulls (0.5 ppm) but not for the proposed tolerance on sunflower seeds (0.2 ppm). For a favorable recommendation we required a revised Section F in which a tolerance of 0.25 ppm was proposed for sunflower seeds. The requested revision is submitted with this amendment. This deficiency is resolved.

Recommendation

Toxicology considerations permitting we recommend for the tolerances proposed for chlorpyrifos on sunflower seeds (0.25 ppm) and sunflower hulls (0.5 ppm).
