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BACKGROUND: Zodiac Pool Care, Inc. has submitted a package which includes a toxicity discussion and a waiver request for all product-specific acute toxicity studies on a product used for swimming pool treatment.

RECOMMENDATIONS: PSB findings are:

All product-specific acute toxicity data can be waived. The "toxicity discussion" discusses the product which is composed of pea-sized pellets of silver-coated alumina spheres (from a call to the agent that represents the registrant) which are encased in a sealed cartridge made of polypropylene or acetal with snap-fit caps. This packaging prevents consumer contact with the spheres. As for inhalation, the water treatment material is bound too well to the carrier matrix to allow for significant inhalation. As for sensitization, the product is not composed of any known sensitizers.
