BACKGROUND:

This is a re-submission to register the above referenced sanitizer under the "me too" registration process. The active ingredient in this formulation is sodium dichloro-s-triazinetrione. This product is cited as being similar to Occidental Chemical's EPA Reg. No. 935-41 ACL 60 EUP Chlorinating Granules.

Submission was prepared by Laird's Regulatory Consultants, Inc. on behalf of the registrant, Aqua-Chlor, S.A. de C.V. of Mexico. Items received in this

re-submission package for review were : Application for Pesticide Registration EPA Form 8570-1, revised CSF dated 3/12/99, product label, 12/30/98 chemistry review by N. Whyte covering AQ 60 Medium Granular and chemistry data for end use product, guideline reference nos. 61, 62 and 63.

FINDINGS:

1. CSF was found to be in compliance. Certified limits were calculated correctly.
2. Chemistry data provided was found complete and acceptable.
3. The use of this disinfectant for "emergency drinking water" was labeled in a manner consistent with substantially similar products e.g. EPA Reg. No. 935-41.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

All requirements for a "me too" product registration were met with this re-submission. It is recommended that this application be accepted.
