SUBJECT: AA BRIEFING ON FOLPET HELD FEBRUARY 18, 1987

ACTION ITEMS WHICH CAME OUT OF THE BRIEFING ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. ALL DUE DATES SHOULD BE REVIEWED CAREFULLY, LESS TIME SHOULD BE GIVEN TO CERTAIN TASKS SUCH AS ASKING FOR HISTORICAL CONTROL DATA.
- ? 2. THE DOSE LEVELS REFERRING TO THE TWO GENERATION FEEDING STUDIES NEED TO BE CLARIFIED.
- ? 3. A DECISION MUST BE MADE ON WHETHER OR NOT TO REQUIRE AN ADDITIONAL MOUSE REPRODUCTION STUDY WITHIN THE NEXT TWO TO THREE MONTHS.
4. OPP SHOULD CONSULT WITH THE OFFICE OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES TO DISCUSS STRUCTURAL ACTIVITY RELATIONSHIPS AND DERMAL ABSORPTION OF FOLPET. THE STUDIES WHICH ARE REQUIRED ON DERMAL ABSORPTION SHOULD STILL BE CONDUCTED.
- ? 5. OPP SHOULD REVIEW WHETHER OR NOT FURTHER STUDIES ARE NEEDED OR NOT SYSTEMIC METABOLITES.
6. A CHART A SUMMARY SHOULD BE MADE COMPARING THE REGULATORY ACTIONS FOR FOLPET, CAPTAN, AND CAPTAFOL.
7. BASED ON THE CURRENT REVIEW, WE HAVE SUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO ASSESS THE HAZARD BUT NOT THE RISK. IT DOES NOT APPEAR THAT ANY TRIGGER FOR SPECIAL REVIEW HAVE BEEN MET AT THIS TIME.

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
