SUBJECT: Alachlor; EPA Reg.#524-316. A Request to Terminate  
Lifetime Rat Feeding Study at Two-Years.

Action Requested:

Monsanto Company is requesting EPA's concurrence to terminate at this time the new Alachlor lifetime chronic feeding study in rats (Long-Evans strain), ML-80-186/224.

Recommendation:

Toxicology Branch has no objection to the termination of this study at this time. The rats have been on test for two years and a NOEL for chronic toxicity needs to be established as soon as possible. Monsanto indicated in a telephone communication by Dr. D. Duncan on 9/17/82 that the survivability of these animals is as follows:
