The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection reported a fish kill caused by Namacur (Fenamiphos) used on golf course. Evidentially, 5 inches of rain fell shortly after application resulting in massive fish die-offs in several lakes receiving runoff from the golf course. Concentrations in lakes ranged from 0-140 ppb. Additional information will be obtained and retained in the monitoring file and Branch file on Namacur. (Dan Rieder, 557-1451)
