The registrant has submitted an application for amended registration to allow the use of Monitor 4, at a rate of 1 1/2 - 2 pints/acre through sprinkler irrigation systems for control of green peach aphid on potatoes in the states of Oregon, Washington and Idaho.

Current labeling for this product specifies use at a dosage rate of 1 1/2 - 2 pints of Monitor 4 per acre for control of aphids on potatoes, with ground or aerial application.

Comments and Recommendations:

- 1. IRB/TSS has no objection to the proposed amendment providing the labeling revision indicated below is made. The basis of this no objection is that this product is currently registered at this application rate for this commodity.
- 2. Amended labeling should specify that this product should not be applied within 14 days of harvest.
